PRAYERWALKING: ANOTHER GUIDE

“Go, walk though the length and breadth of the land, for I am giving it to you.”

(Gen 13:17, NIV)

Once you've practiced prayerwalking a few times, you will find that you are getting more comfortable with the concept. You've prayed the Lord's prayer over your community repeatedly, and you're probably already adding your own words to the prayers. Now it's time to begin praying with various Scripture passages - first with some that are written out and later with those you've memorized. This guide is an example to get you started down that exciting road! It is a powerful thing to call on God in agreement with His written Word!

Praying Ephesians 1:3-10

“Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ.”

- **Praise** God as you walk through the community.
- **Thank** God that the community exists for His praise. Thank God for the good things in your community.
- **Praise** God for points of light in the darkness (churches, homes and businesses that honour Christ)
- **Thank** God for His blessing, reserved in heaven for those who live here and do His will.
- **Pray** that the community might be blessed with an awareness of God and know the Name of Christ.
- **Pray** that all in the community might know the blessing of Christ (salvation).

“For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight.”

- **Acknowledge** that God purposes good things for the people of this community.
- **Pray** that the community would honour God.
- **Pray** for righteous decisions to be made by those in authority in the community.
- **Pray** that His Spirit would move to bring the community to a place of repentance.
- **Pray** that the people will be strengthened to resist temptation.

“In love he predestined us to be adopted as his sons through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will.”

- **Ask** that we (His servants) would have His love for those here in the community.
- **Remember** that Christ died for all. The price is already paid.
- **Acknowledge** that it is God’s will and pleasure to bring salvation to all in the community.

“to the praise of his glorious grace, which he has freely given us in the One he loves.”

- **Praise** God for His grace already shown.
- **Praise** God for the free gift of eternal life in Christ.
- **Thank** Him for those who volunteer in the community.
- **Ask** God that more people would be willing to give as He gives.

“In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God’s grace that he lavished on us with all wisdom and understanding.”

- **Acknowledge** that for the people of this community God paid such a high price.
- **Remember** the power of Christ’s blood. There is no sin and no blight on the community that God cannot redeem.
- **Ask** for His lavish grace to be poured out in mercy on all those in the community.
